

Compliance with relevant laws

George Clinical Pty Ltd, together with its subsidiaries worldwide (**George Clinical**) is committed to complying with the ICH Good Clinical Practice Guide (**GCP**) and handling Personal Information in accordance with applicable privacy laws.

If you agree, what sort of information will we retain?

If you join the Database, we may retain the following Personal Information about you:

- your name, address, contact details, job title, organisation address, professional qualifications, work experience, professional registrations (**Your Information** and **My Information**).

Please note if you do not wish to join the Database, your personal information will remain part of any records relating to the study or research activity you have been involved in as required by law and GCP.

How will Your Information be used?

Your Information may be used to:

- Contact you for potential work or collaboration on other studies or research activities;
- Contact you to ensure that the information we hold is kept accurate and up to date; or
- Refer or recommend you to other research institutions, collaborators, sponsors or contract research organisations (CROs).

We will not sell Your Information.

Who else might Your Information be given to?

We may disclose Your Information:

- to our staff and relevant third parties (such as database providers which host our databases, other research institutions, collaborators, sponsors and CROs (together **Collaborators**);
- If disclosure is required by law;
- to comply with legal, regulatory, or insurance obligations or applications for funding or initiating projects or studies.

Collaborators will be required to respect the security of Your Information and to treat it in accordance with the law.

How will Your Information be kept?

Your Information will be kept securely in accordance with our Privacy Policy. Please refer to our website: www.georgeclinical.com (or for China www.georgeclinical.cn) for further information.

How long will Your Information be stored?

We will only retain Your Information for as long as reasonably necessary, including for the purposes of satisfying any business, legal or regulatory requirements. You may also request that we remove Your Information from the Database at any time.

Transfer of Your Information

As a global business we may transfer Your Information within George Clinical and to our agents, partners or contractors. This may involve transferring your information across international borders. Some of these countries may have different data protection laws and standards to those in your country of

residence. However, these recipients are restricted from using your information in way other than to provide services for us. We will take steps to ensure adequate protections are in place to ensure the security of Your Information. For example, transfers to non-EEA countries will include putting in place “approved” Standard Contractual Clauses to protect Your Information.

Your Rights

You have Rights in relation to Your Information held by George Clinical including:

| The right of access | You have the right to request access to your Personal Information that we hold about you. |
| The right to rectification | You are entitled to request corrections to the Personal Information that we hold about you if it is inaccurate or incomplete. |
| The right to erasure | This is also known as “the right to be forgotten” and enables you to request the deletion or removal of your Personal Information if there is no compelling or legal reason for us to keep using it. |
| The right to restriction of processing | You have the right to ask us to suspend the processing of Personal Information about you, for example if you want us to establish its accuracy or the reason for processing it. |
| The right to object to processing | You have the right to object and ask us to stop processing your Personal Information. |
| The right to lodge a complaint | You have the right to lodge a complaint about the way we process your Personal Information with the relevant supervisory authority. |
| The right to request transfer | You have the right to request us to transfer Personal Information that we hold about you to another party, in a machine-readable format. |
| The right to withdraw your consent | You have the right to withdraw your consent to us processing your Personal Information. |
| The right to seek explanation of how we process your Personal Information | We will explain how your Personal Information is processed, however if you do not understand, you have the right to seek further explanation |
| The right to opt out of sale | We do not sell identifiable information about individuals involved in clinical research studies |
| The right to non-discrimination | We will not discriminate against you for the exercise of your privacy rights |
| The right to automated decision making | You have the right to not be subject to a decision based solely on automated processing (i.e., processing without human intervention). |

You have the right to request that we disclose certain information about our collection and use of your Personal Information over the past twelve months
